This course aims to complete the cycle of acquainting the student with the classical literary heritage through examining the Ismaili thought upon which the Fatimid dynasty in Egypt and Morocco was based. It examines the most important literary phenomena and artistic and thematic properties of Fatimid, Ayyubid and Mamluk literature by studying some prominent sample literature which constitutes the intellectual, religious and literary features of this era.
