101332	Arabic Syntax 3	(3 credit hours)	( prerequisite "101231")

This course coaches students in researching specialized topics in Arabic syntax, and trains them in some broad subjects, such as: the adjective, the appositional, the emphatic, and conjunction, and some specific subjects, such as: prepositions and their senses and their impact on meaning, particles of the genitive construction, real and verbal genitives, and the function of derivatives and verbal nouns. This course also examines sentences with and without grammatical cases in 'I'rab. It finally cites Quranic verses, prophetic hadith, and some poetry and prose for inspection and substantiating.
