Teaching Thinking (110821)

Thinking is one of the most essential topics because of the significant role it plays in the teaching and learning of basic skills. The major goal of teaching thinking is to improve students' thinking skills which help them succeed in their life. It also urges enquiry research, not to accept facts without investigation.
