English phonetics introduces students into the human body and the organs used in voice production. It also provides detailed classification and description of English consonants and vowels on the basis of an international notation system (IPA and Cardinal vowel chart).

* Objectives:

Students are expected to master the major topic areas in the voice production process (articulatory Phonetics) including: the description of speech sounds (consonants and vowels); and the phonetic transcription using the IPA and the Cardinal Vowel Chart.

* Outcomes

To enable students of English to produce English sounds (consonants & vowels) correctly as well as distinguish between these sounds on the basis of phonetic transcription and their corresponding pronunciation.
