Dr. Mohammad Almajali is heading the Mechanical Engineering Department at Mutah University. In 1989 he graduated from Jordan University of Science and Technology (JUST) as a Mechanical/Aeronautical Engineering. Immediately after that, he enrolled in Royal Jordanian Air Force (RJAF) as a maintenance officer.
