

1.3.5 Low or lower-middle-income countries student support

The university aims to offer educational opportunities to low-income local and regional students. The University is committed to providing incentives and discounts for both graduate and undergraduate students, regardless of whether they are Jordanian or non-Jordanian. Non-Jordanian students receive the same benefits as Jordanian students, including transportation services and health insurance, and they also have access to the health centre and pharmacy services. Isra University attracts students from neighbouring low-income countries, such as Egypt and Syria and offers opportunities to refugees residing in Jordan.
