



5.6.2 Non-discrimination policies for transgender

Although Isra University and Jordanian did not explicitly state non-discrimination towards transgender, it is implied as a human right. It is part of the Jordanian constitution Article 6: <u>The Constitution of The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (istd.gov.jo)</u>. that states:

"Article 6

- (i) Jordanians shall be equal before the law. There shall be no discrimination between them as regards to their rights and duties on grounds of <u>race</u>, <u>language or religion</u>.
- (ii) The Government shall ensure work and education within the limits of its possibilities, and it shall ensure a state of tranquillity and equal opportunities to all Jordanians.
