17.2 Relationships to support the goals

17.2.1 Relationships with regional NGOs and government for SDG policy

Isra University works to build relationships with regional NGOs and government agencies to advance Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) policy by serving as a collaborative hub that connects academic research with community and policy needs. Here are a few brief approaches that we endeavour:

• **Joint Research and Projects**: IU partnered with NGOs and government bodies in Jordan and the region to conduct research or pilot projects aligned with the SDGs. 73.6% of the research conducted at IU is collaborative. Isra University has made various agreements and activities with national, regional, and international entities for collaboration towards sustainability. Signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between Al-Isra University and the National Center for Human Rights

Prof. Mohamed Hamed (President of the University) indicated that this agreement consolidates the university's commitment to the development of partnership with local and international community institutions, especially the National Center for Human Rights, which will participate with the university in projects of building the capacity of the local community, the integration of the elderly, workshops related to human rights, and the introduction of the annual report on human rights in order to achieve effective cooperation in achieving



the university's vision of knowledge and empowerment related to human values. Al-Isra is a house of expertise in the development of companies with local and international community institutions, and this agreement will open new horizons of research and training cooperation, and indicated the importance of the center in developing the human rights awareness system through the report that the center issues annually.

A delegation from the Association of the Residents of Kafraana visits Al-Isra University

At the beginning of the meeting, His Excellency the President of the University welcomed the distinguished guests and assured them of the keenness of Al-Isra University to build partnerships with local community institutions, and gave them a summary of the academic programs offered by the university to students at the bachelor's, higher diploma and master's levels. His Excellency also stressed that the university has adopted the slogan "Knowledge and Empowerment" out of its belief in the need for the university's graduates to be able to compete in the labor market through the development of new specializations that keep pace with technological development and excellence in supporting medical specialties. His Excellency pointed out that The President said that Isra University holds many international accreditations and local and international quality certificates. For his part, Mr. Talaat Daghmash, President of the Association of the Residents of Kafra'ana, pointed out that the partnership with Al-Isra University has been extended for years, as its aim is to support students by providing them with grants and discounts.

For his part, Prof. Hamed stressed the -keenness of AlIsraUniversity to strengthen cultural relations and open new horizons in an environment of openness and respect for the opinions of others, expressing his happiness with the strategic partnership with the German-Jordanian University, and his thanks and appreciation for the warm welcome and reception, and his hope for fruitful and constructive cooperation between the two sides in the near future.

<u>Signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between Al-Isra University and the</u> National Center for Creativity

On Wednesday, 12/6/2024, Al-Isra University and the National Center for Creativity signed a memorandum of understanding with the aim of framing and strengthening the bonds of joint cooperation in the field of scientific research development and stimulating creativity and entrepreneurial projects. The memorandum was signed on behalf of the university, its president, His Excellency Prof. Dr. Mohamed Hamed, and on behalf of the center, its president, His Excellency Dr. Jihad Muhaidat, in the presence of Dr. Shatha Al-Assaf from the Faculty of Law. tireless efforts to fulfill their responsibilities towards the nation to serve scientific research, creativity and leadership, and to stimulate cooperation between the concerned institutions in the system of creativity, innovation and scientific research, and to enhance the exchange of knowledge and experiences between them. The MoU seeks to support and develop creativity and innovation at the National Center for Creativity -as AlIsraUniversity is one of the active universities in the field of innovation and entrepreneurship, and the MoU is in line with the decision of the Council of Higher Education to adopt the Jordan Open Platform for Creativity (JOIP) as an official platform for gathering scientific research, creativity and



innovation activities, and as a national platform for researchers as an official reference for Jordanian universities, faculty members and researchers.

Memorandum of Understanding between Al-Isra University and Al-Muwaqqar Municipality
