Isra University is committed to follow the labour law that prohibit slavery policy: Outline a strong stance against forced labor and exploitation within hiring, supply chains, and partnerships.

Jordan has made significant efforts to combat modern slavery, particularly through anti-trafficking laws and initiatives. The **Anti-Human Trafficking Law No. 9 of 2009, amended in 2019**, (https://ahtnc.org.jo/sites/default/files/anti-human_trafficking_law.pdf), imposes strict penalties, including up to ten years' imprisonment for forced labour or prostitution and other aggravated trafficking cases. Therefore, we at IU are committed to the law.
